Amendment 6 to Issue 1 of the Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to the Annex to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012

'AMC and GM to the rules of the air — Issue 1, Amendment 6'

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY (EASA),

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2018/1139¹, and in particular Article 104(3)(a) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) EASA shall, pursuant to Article 76(3) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, issue certification specifications and acceptable means of compliance, as well as guidance material, for the application of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and of the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof.
- (2) Acceptable means of compliance are non-binding standards issued by EASA which may be used by persons and organisations to demonstrate compliance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof, or with the related certification specifications and detailed specifications.
- (3) Guidance material is non-binding material issued by EASA which helps to illustrate the meaning of a requirement or specification and is used to support the interpretation of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof, certification specifications and detailed specifications.

Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2018 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Union Aviation Safety Agency, and amending Regulations (EC) No 2111/2005, (EC) No 1008/2008, (EU) No 996/2010, (EU) No 376/2014 and Directives 2014/30/EU and 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulations (EC) No 552/2004 and (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EEC) No 3922/91 (OJ L 212, 22.8.2018, p. 1) (<u>https://eurlex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/?qid=1535612134845&uri=CELEX:32018R1139</u>).



- (4) With Decision 2013/013/R² of 17 July 2013, the Executive Director issued Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012 of 26 September 2012 laying down the common rules of the air and operational provisions regarding services and procedures in air navigation³.
- (5) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012 was amended by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/666 of 22 April 2021 as regards requirements for manned aviation operating in U-space airspace⁴.
- (6) EASA shall, pursuant to Article 4(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the field of aviation, and in particular as regards the U-space airspace, U-space services and technical systems, and update its decisions taking into account worldwide aviation experience and the latest scientific and technical progress in the respective fields.
- (7) Therefore, the Executive Director shall amend the existing acceptable means of compliance and guidance material to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012 to reflect the amendments introduced by the insertion of provisions on the U-Space airspace in that Regulation.
- (8) EASA, pursuant to Article 115(1)(c) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and Article 6 of the EASA Rulemaking Procedure⁵, has widely consulted the interested parties on the content of this Decision, and provided thereafter a written response⁶ to the comments received through the consultation,

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

The Annex to ED Decision 2013/013/R is amended as laid down in the Annex to this Decision.
