## **DECISION 2014/010/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY**

**of 26 February 2014**

### **amending Certification Specifications for European Technical Standard Orders (CS-ETSO)**

#### **'CS-ETSO – Amendment 9'**

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 38(3)(a) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 748/2012<sup>2</sup>, and in particular 21.A.16A of the Annex (Part-21) thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18(c) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, issue Certification Specifications and Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.
- (2) Certification Specifications are technical standards adopted by the Agency which indicate the means to show compliance with Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules and which can be used by organisations for the purpose of certification.
- (3) With Decision No 2003/10/RM of 24 October 2003 the Executive Director adopted Certification Specifications for European Technical Standard Orders (CS-ETSO<sup>3</sup>).

- (4) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 19(2) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the fields concerned and update its Decisions taking into account worldwide aircraft experience in service, and scientific and technical progress.
- (5) The Agency has determined a need to improve the Certification Specifications CS-ETSO with respect to equipment approval, by amending ETSO-C165, to account for changes in technology and industry expectations, in relation to Airport Moving Map Displays (AMMD) which can be hosted in Electronic Flight Bags (EFB).
- (6) The Agency, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and Articles 5(3), 6 and 7 of the Agency's Rulemaking Procedure<sup>4</sup>, has widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received<sup>5</sup>.

HAS DECIDED:

**Article 1**

The Annex to Decision No 2003/10/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 24 October 2003 of is amended as laid down in the Annex to this Decision.

**Article 2**

This Decision shall enter into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2014.
