DECISION N° 17-2014

of 08 December 2014

TO TRANSFER MR TREVOR WOODS AS CERTIFICATION DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) 216/20082 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC thereof;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/683;

Having noted the failed Certification Director selection procedure;

Having regard to EASA MB Decision 09-20114, appointing the Agency's Approvals and Standardisation Director;

Having examined the proposal of the Executive Director of the Agency;

Has decided:

To transfer, in the interest of the service, Mr Trevor Woods as Certification Director of EASA as of 1 March 2015, for the rest of his 5 year mandate.

And has asked the Executive Director to initiate the publication of the vacancy for the post of Flight Standards Director, currently occupied by Mr Trevor Woods.

This present decision shall have effect as of the date of its adoption.
