DECISION N° 08-2017

of 28 November 2017

ADOPTING THE EUROPEAN PLAN FOR AVIATION SAFETY (EPAS) 2018-2022 INCLUDING THE RULEMAKING PROGRAMME

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) N° 216/2008² of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) N° 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC, hereinafter referred to as 'the Basic Regulation' and in particular to Article 52 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 18-2015 of the Management Board (MB) of 15 December 2015 concerning the procedure to be applied by the Agency for the issuing of opinions, certification specifications, acceptable means of compliance and guidance material (the 'Rulemaking Procedure'), and repealing Decision 01-2012 of the MB of 13 March 2012,

Whereas:

- (1) The Executive Director shall establish annually a 5-year Rulemaking Programme after consultation with the Member States and the Interested Parties' Advisory Bodies, including consultation with the European Commission,
- (2) The Rulemaking Programme shall be aligned with the corresponding multi-annual work programme (SPD) and shall be submitted to the Management Board as an annex to the multi-annual work programme,

Has decided to adopt the EPAS 2018-2022 including the Rulemaking Programme, as set out in the annexed document.
