DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY ADMITTING THE EUROPEAN LOW FARES AIRLINE ASSOCIATION AS MEMBER OF THE EASA ADVISORY BOARD
