The request by Turbomeca of 30 October 2012 to surrender EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.E.073, with regard to the ARRIEL 1A turboshaft engine model, has been accepted by EASA.

In accordance with the applicable EASA administrative procedures<sup>2</sup>, the proposal to surrender the Type Certificate related to ARRIEL 1A turboshaft engine was published on the EASA website for public consultation under EASA Certification Information 2013 – 10 dated 10 October, 2013. There were no comments made to the public consultation and therefore EASA decided to accept the surrender of the aforementioned Type Certificate. EASA has submitted the decision to revoke Type Certificate No. EASA.E.073 to the Type Certificate Holder on 04 April 2014.

## Consequence:

Regarding the continuation of turboshaft engine models ARRIEL 1A1, ARRIEL 1A2, ARRIEL 1B, ARRIEL 1C, ARRIEL 1C1, ARRIEL 1C2, ARRIEL 1D, ARRIEL 1D1, ARRIEL 1D1, ARRIEL 1E2, ARRIEL 1K, ARRIEL 1K1, ARRIEL 1S, ARRIEL 1S1, which were also covered under EASA Type Certificate EASA.E.073, EASA has re-issued EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.E.073, dated04 April 2014. In relation to the ARRIEL 1A turboshaft engine model, any aircraft registered in an EU Member State on which the engine has been installed will no longer be eligible for a normal Certificate of Airworthiness according to Article 5(c) of Regulation (EC) No. 216/2008<sup>3</sup>.

For aircraft registered outside the EU, operators should contact their State of Registry for a decision on the continuing validity of any certificates they have issued.
