**Please Note the following guidelines concerning the conference and the presentations:**

- This is a call for presenters, not a call for registration. A separate call for registration with instructions will be sent when registration is open.
- If you would like to propose a presentation, please note the following principles:
  - we would like to offer some benefits to presenters, like free registration and a reserved seat in the front rows. Travel Expenses and Hotel are excluded.
  - Presentations should be related to FDM, methods of analysing Flight Data or its use for airline safety purposes.
  - The content of your presentation must be of general interest. Presenting yourself and your organisation should not take more than 2 minutes. Please do not use this presentation to advertise. Presentations with a marketing influence cannot be accepted.
  - Slides and oral comments must be given in English language. Please do not refrain from volunteering if your English language is not perfect: most participants are not English native speakers and they value first and foremost the technical content of presentations.
  - The participation to this conference is open to all aviation professionals, so you should decide what can be shown and what must not.
  - We have sometimes to make a difficult choice between topics of equal interest. If a proposal is not retained, it does not mean that it is not valuable. In any case we are very thankful for all presentation proposals!
  - A first selection will be made on the topics proposed, but presentations will be confirmed only after review of the corresponding slide shows. We are available all along the preparation process to advise presenters in the organisation and the format of their presentation.
