The European Commission has recently adopted new regulations amending Commission Regulations (EC) Nos. 1702/2003 and 2042/2002, introducing elaborated requirements for the issuance of permits to fly. To support the implementation of these amendments the Agency has issued a Decision amending the Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Part 21.

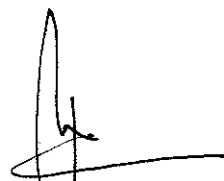
