The objective of the workshop is to inform European industry about results of continued effort of the three Authorities - the FAA, Transport Canada, and the European Aviation Safety Agency - which joined forces in the International Implementation Team (IIT) to monitor and, as far as necessary, to improve implementation of the paragraphs 21.101 and 21.19 of Part 21 related to the Changed Product Rule (CPR) and Substantial changes.
