Which pilots need to undergo what kind of UPRT?

Answer:

The different 'levels' of UPRT (please refer to the FAQ 'What is UPRT?') will be integrated into pilot training as follows:

basic UPRT

 all modular and integrated CPL and ATP training courses for aeroplanes as well as the integrated MPL training course

'advanced UPRT course'

- Part of
 - integrated ATP course
 - integrated MPL course

Pre-requisite to

- training courses for single-pilot class or type ratings operated in multipilot operations
- training courses for single-pilot high performance complex aeroplanes
- training courses for multi-pilot aeroplanes

class-or type-related UPRT

- training courses for single-pilot high performance complex aeroplanes
- training courses for multi-pilot aeroplanes
- bridge course for extending privileges on a single-pilot aeroplane to multipilot operations
