Background: The current holder of EASA Type Certificates (TC) EASA.A.369 and

When doing so, EASA also asks you to inform them about the possibility, no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2013, of commenting on the above and/or of expressing their will to take over the ownership of the Type Certificates following its surrender. Transfer of the Type Certificates requires that the new owner demonstrate competence to fulfil the necessary obligations of a Type Certificate Holder in accordance with the applicable rules.

A list of the individuals directly concerned and other possible interested persons should be sent to EASA.

After satisfactory evaluation of the surrender request, taking into account the comments received, EASA will accept the request and take the decision to revoke or transfer the Type Certificates in accordance with the applicable administrative procedures.
