





Areas of Concern



Decreased operation robustness

Staff wellbeing

Operational pressure

Incorrect crew pairings

Increased workload

Unavailability of crew members

Increase in the number of unruly passengers

Scheduling through Commander's descretion





What can authorities do?



Coordinate information sharing at authority level between departments



Anticipate (if possible) by meeting with the accountable manager to understand the main areas of concern



Focus during scheduled oversight activities on "hot spots" (e.g. SMS, FTL, Fatigue, Training, etc)



What can we do?




Coordinate information sharing at authority level between departments, between organisations and within organisations



Anticipate by discussing the main areas of concern/ safety issues with between authorities and organisations, as well as within your organisation



Focus on "hot spots" (such as SMS, FTL, Fatigue, Training etc) during authority oversight activities and internal audits and monitoring
