Issue The Charter of the IMRBPB limits this body to regulatory authorities

Problem The policy board does not contain all specialist knowledge much naturally

rest within the industry. Many issue are discussed which require industry input. Many issues require the advice and/or action/implementation by industry. This can result in delays as the actions are passed from the board

to industry and back again.

Recommendation.

It is recommended that the IMRBPB charter be revised to include a provision that industry representatives may be co-opted on to the board to assist the IMRBPB when specific knowledge and /or advise is required.

IMRBPB Position.

August 20, 2003

SMEs may be brought into IMRBPB meetings to deal with specific issues, there will be no extended membership offered to non-regulatory bodies.
