ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AERODROME'S CERTIFICATION BASIS (CB) On the site support



Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro have transposed the Commission Regulation (EU) No 139/2014 and started its implementation. The first aerodrome to be certified in accordance with regulation is Sarajevo International Airport (SIA). The process of obtaining such an aerodrome certificate includes the establishment of the aerodrome's Certification Basis (CB) to describe the infrastructure and equipment in terms of the regulatory requirements which they are meant to comply with. This CB document is proposed by the applicant (usually the aerodrome operator) and is finally decided on by the Competent Authority, the State entity designated to certify and oversee aerodromes.

The activity supported experts from Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation (BHDCA), Montenegro Civil Aviation Agency and SIA in evaluation and establishment of proposed CB which will serve as the basis for conversion of the national certificate. The lessons learned will be used in conversion processes of remaining aerodromes in respective countries.

The activity was implemented from 06 - 10 September 2021 in BHDCA premises in Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina.

In total 8 participants from 2 beneficiary countries attended the activity.
