AERODROME'S CERTIFICATION SPECIFICATION DEVIATIONS On the site support



Regulation (EU) No. 139/2014 is transposed into Montenegrin and Bosnia and Herzegovinian national regulations, allowing for deviations from technical requirements (CSs) during the certification process. This flexibility is provided by means of: Equivalent Level of Safety (ELoS), Special Condition (SC) or Deviation Acceptance and Action Document (DAAD).

As beneficiary countries experts still have no experiences with abovementioned flexibilities, the expert from Croatian Civil Aviation Agency (CCAA) has prepared an overview of relevant current EU regulations, experiences and best practices collected during (re)certification of aerodromes in Croatia.

As a part of the activity, the expert evaluated and commented, jointly with beneficiary countries experts, deviations from CSs on Podgorica Airport and Tivat Airport, including proposed means of flexibility for each deviation and several related safety assessments. A visit to Tivat Airport was organised where participants had opportunity to observe and discuss practical aspects.

By clarifying the applicable provisions from Regulation (EU) No 139/2014 and by sharing experiences related to infrastructure certification process and flexibility means for handling of non-compliances, easier understanding and more efficient implementation of beneficiaries' side is enabled.

The activity was implemented from 27 - 30 September 2021 in Podgorica, Montenegro. In total 8 participants from 2 Montenegro and Bosnia and Herzegovina attended the activity.
