DECISION 2014/012/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY

of 27 February 2014

adopting Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Regulation (EU) No 139/2014

`AMC/GM for Aerodromes – Initial Issue'

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No $216/2008^1$ and in particular Article 38(3)(a) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EU) No 139/2014², and in particular Annex II, ADR.AR.A.015 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18(c) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, issue Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.
- (2) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 19, points 2(a) and (b) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 develop Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material which shall reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the field concerned.
- (3) Acceptable Means of Compliance are non-binding standards adopted by the Agency which illustrate the means to establish compliance with Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.
- (4) Guidance Material is non-binding material developed by the Agency which helps to illustrate the meaning of a requirement or specification and is used to support the interpretation of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, its Implementing Rules, Certification Specifications and Acceptable Means of Compliance.

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

The Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to the Commission Regulation (EU) No 139/2014 are those laid down in the Annex to this Decision.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the 6th of March 2014.
