EXPLANATORY NOTE

AMC-20 Amendment 4

1. GENERAL

Executive Director Decision 2008/007/R amends Executive Director Decision No 2003/12/RM of 5 November 2003 on general acceptable means of compliance for airworthiness of products, parts and appliances (AMC-20 Initial Issue) as last amended by Executive Director Decision 2008/004/R of 25 April 2008 (AMC-20 Amendment 3). It represents Amendment 4 of AMC-20, and incorporates the output from the following EASA rulemaking task:

The Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA) has been subject to consultation in accordance with Article 52 of the Basic Regulation¹ and Article 15 of the Rulemaking Procedure established by the Management Board². For detailed information on the proposed changes and their justification please consult the above NPA which is available on the Agency's website.

The Agency has addressed and responded to the comments received on this NPA. The responses are contained in a comment-response document (CRD) which has been produced for this NPA (CRD 2007-01) and which is also available on the Agency's website.

The AMCs proposed in this NPA are included in the AMC-20 book since they provide acceptable means of compliance to the certification specifications for large aeroplanes ("CS-25") as well as to Regulation (EC) No 1702/2003³ and Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003⁴.

2. CRD REACTIONS

The Agency received no reactions on the comments and responses related to the new AMCs in AMC-20 as reflected in CRD 2007-01.
