# DECISION N° 2008/004/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY

**OF 25 APRIL 2008** 

AMENDING DECISION NO 2003/12/RM OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY OF 05 NOVEMBER 2003 ON GENERAL ACCEPTABLE MEANS OF COMPLIANCE FOR AIRWORTHINESS OF PRODUCTS, PARTS AND APPLIANCES (« AMC-20 »)

### THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC¹ (hereinafter referred to as the "Basic Regulation"), and in particular Articles 18 and 19 thereof,

Having regard to the Commission Regulation (EC) No 1702/2003 of 24 September 2003 laying down implementing rules for the airworthiness and environmental certification of aircraft and related products, parts and appliances, as well as for the certification of design and production organisations<sup>2</sup>,

#### Whereas:

- (1) The Executive Director issued general acceptable means of compliance for airworthiness of products, parts and appliances (« AMC-20 ») in the Annex to Executive Director Decision No 2003/12/RM of 5 November 2003 (Initial Issue).
- (2) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue certification specifications, including airworthiness codes and acceptable means of compliance, as well as guidance material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its implementing rules.
- (3) The Agency is obliged, pursuant to Article 19 of the Basic Regulation to reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the fields concerned and update certification specifications taking into account world wide aircraft experience in service, and scientific and technical progress.
- (4) Agency, pursuant to Article 52.1(c) of the Basic Regulation and articles 5(3) and 6 of the EASA rulemaking procedure<sup>3</sup>, has widely consulted interested

parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received. (see: CRD 2007/05).

HAS DECIDED:

#### Article 1

The Annex "General Acceptable Means of Compliance for Airworthiness of Products, Parts and Appliances (AMC-20)" to Decision No 2003/12/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency is hereby modified in accordance with the Annexes to this Decision.

## Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on 2 May 2008. It shall be published in the *Official Publication of the Agency*.
