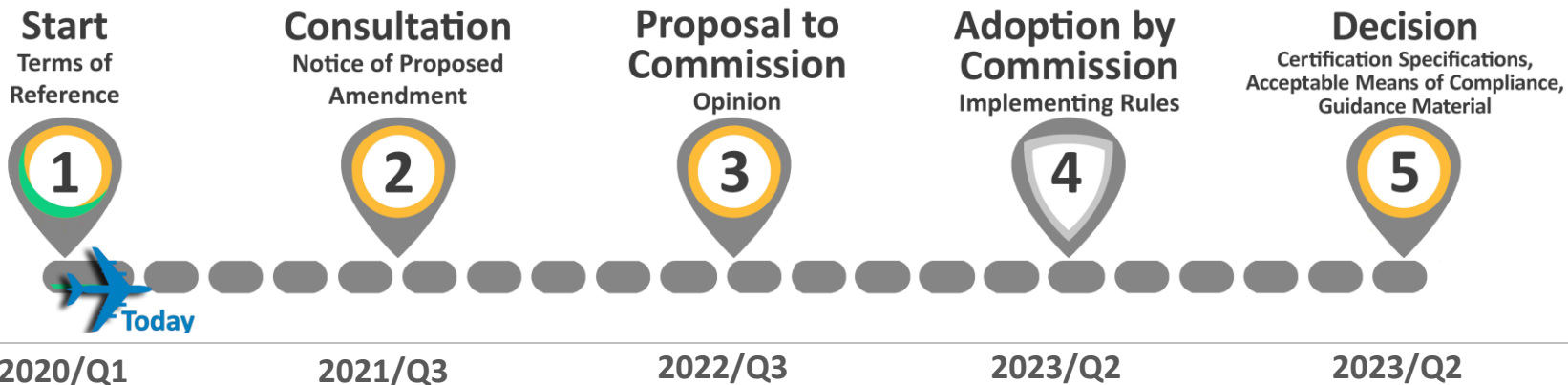

After the wokshop

- Draft RMT.0161 ToR to be consolidated after the Workshop
 - Circulated for consultation with EASA Advisory Bodies by Christmas
 - Possible deadline for comments: 31 January 2020
- A RMG is to be created to support EASA
 - NPA drafting phases (binding and non-binding rules)
 - Review of the comments received during the NPA public consultation
 - Focused consultation
 - Collection of expertise and relevant data
 - Composed of ATM/ANS providers, ground equipment manufacturers, national competent authorities, aerodrome operators
 - Nomination of participants i.a.w. usual EASA procedures

Planned milestones

• EASA rulemaking process milestones



RMT.0161 on Conformity Assessment

- Options underpinned by a regulatory impact assessment (RIA)
- A framework valid for existing systems, but looking at the future:
 - introduction of new capabilities and functionalities
 - stakeholders' trust in new initiatives that deploy high-tech ground equipment, e.g. ATM Master Plan solutions
 - Recognition of EC declarations issued i.a.w. the IOP Regulation
- Complementing Regulation (EU) 2017/373 to ensure compliance with the ERs
