- Many thanks and appreciations were presented to all participants and contributors, also for the fairness of the discussions and dialogue.
- Summary of actions:
 - IORS: EASA will start to feed the system and feedback will be provided;
 - Interface DO-MO: best practices to be published;
 - CVE: feedback following audits expected from EASA and DOA's;
 - For test houses, the implementation of a system avoiding multiple auditing activities is needed; a scheme similar to ICOP, with additional Acceptable Means of Compliane or Guidance Material, could be implemented rather quickly; Industry is encouraged to cooperate, share experience and propose a single concrete scheme as soon as possible (2012);
 - Bilateral Agreement EU-USA: EASA workshop on TIP to be explored;
- Industry is further encouraged to make presentations during the next DOA implementation workshop; a call for paper will be launched before the summer break.
- Possible subjects for the next DOA workshop are:
 - IORS
 - OSD
 - CVE
 - Interface DO-MO
 - ISM
 - Test houses
