Subject:	Notice of intent to revoke EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.A.563 for the SKYCAR aircraft model issued to OMA SUD SKY TECHNOLOGIES SPA due to non-compliance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2019/2153 <sup>1</sup> on the fees and charges levied by the European Union Aviation Safety Agency

Background:	OMA SUD SKY TECHNOLOGIES SPA is the holder of EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.A.563 for the SKYCAR aircraft model issued by EASA on 08 January 2010.
	According to Article 8 (2) of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2019/2153 in conjunction with Table 8 of Part 1 of the Annex to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2019/2153 holders of EASA Type Certificates are required to pay an annual fee related to the certification tasks carried out by the Agency for the purpose of maintaining the EASA Type Certificates.
	Despite several reminders, OMA SUD SKY TECHNOLOGIES SPA fails to fulfil the payment obligations imposed by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2019/2153.
	Due to this persistent non-compliance, EASA intends to revoke EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.A.563 for the SKYCAR aircraft model in accordance with Article 11 (1) of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 2019/2153 in conjunction with point 21.A.51 of Annex I (Part 21) to Commission Regulation (EU) No 748/2012 <sup>2</sup> .

After satisfactory evaluation of the comments received, if any, EASA may take the decision to revoke EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.A.563 for the SKYCAR aircraft model in accordance with the applicable administrative procedures established by EASA.
