

**EXAMPLE 1: ONE SINGLE ORGANISATION PERFORMS BASE MAINTENANCE  
(PMO) (and there is no additional line maintenance)**

**NOTE: If there is a need for this organisation to perform some additional line maintenance after the aircraft comes out of the hangar (some servicing, etc), it may be considered as being part of the Base Maintenance event and may be covered by the BMRC.**

**EXAMPLE 3: ONE ORGANISATION PERFORMS LINE MAINTENANCE (PMO) AND THERE IS AN ADDITIONAL ORGANISATION SENT BY THE OPERATOR TO REPLACE AN ENGINE (also considered Line Maintenance)**

1) The organisation replacing the engine issues an MRC as follows:

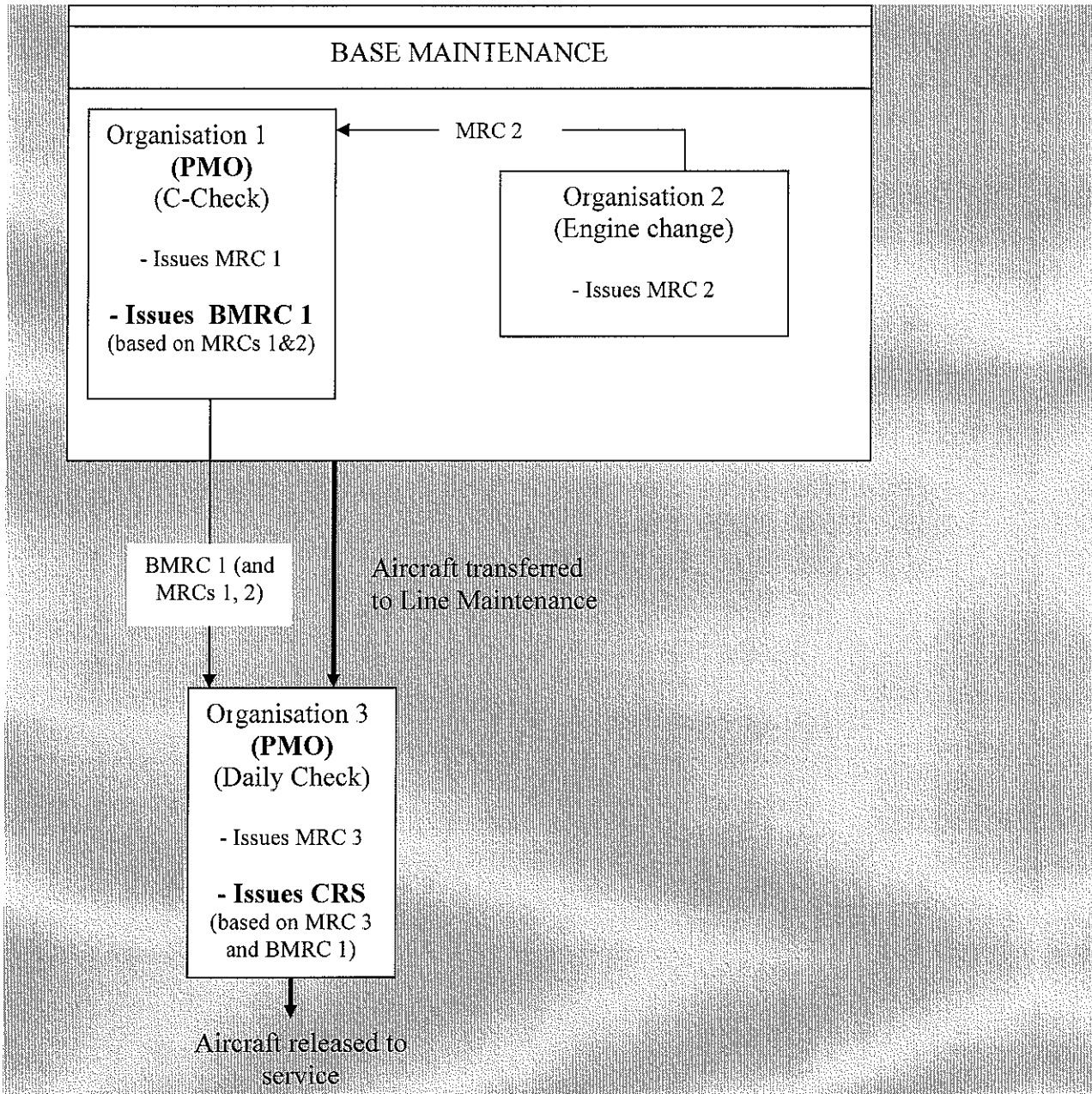

### EXAMPLE 4

- Organisation 1 performs a “C-Check” (PMO) and Organisation 2 performs an “Engine Change” on engine N°1.
- The aircraft goes out of the hangar
- During the following night, Organisation 3 (PMO) performs a Daily Check. They find a problem on engine 2 and they have to correct the discrepancy. The Operator should have informed Organisation 3 that when two engines are disturbed there is a need for a flight test.



**Organisation 2 (the one replacing the engine) issues MRC 2 as follows:**
