Subject: Notice of intent to suspend EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.BA.022 for SUP-AIR Hot Air Balloons, SUP-AIR Series: D-AX 5, F-AX 7, B-AX 8, C-AX 9 and E-AX-10

Background:

SUP-AIR Ballon Egyesület is the holder of European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) Type Certificate No. EASA.BA.022 for the SUP-AIR Series hot air balloons: D-AX 5, F-AX 7, B-AX 8, C-AX 9 and E-AX-10.

The abovementioned hot air balloons were granted with the EASA Type Certificate on 3 December 2010, in accordance with Article 3(1)(a)(i) of Commission Regulation (EU) No 748/2012¹ (Part-21), based on the initial TCs issued by the Hungarian Civil Aviation Authority (CAA-HU) as follows: n° 57HB50, issued 16 March 1992; n° 57HB70, n° 57HB80, n° 57HB90 and n° 57HB10, all issued 24 February 1994.

On 22.05.2025, the approval under Alternative Procedures to Design Organisation Approval No. EASA.AP335 was revoked in accordance with Article 62(2)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139.

Following the revocation of the APDOA, the Agency considers that SUP-AIR Ballon Egyesület no longer demonstrates the capability required under 21.A.14 of Commission Regulation (EU) No 748/2012 to fulfil its obligations as Type Certificate holder.

The Agency therefore considers that EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.BA.022 may no longer have a valid and compliant Type Certificate holder and intends to suspend the EASA TC, in accordance with 21.A.51 of Part-21.

Before taking the final decision, EASA hereby requests that any natural or legal person to whom this suspension could be of direct and individual concern, as well as other possible interested persons, comment on EASA's intention to suspend the EASA TC and/or express their willingness to take over the abovementioned EASA TC by **17.04.2026**.

EASA will take the decision to suspend EASA Type Certificate No. EASA.BA.022 or to initiate its transfer in accordance with 21.A.47 of Part-21 and the applicable administrative procedures established by EASA, after evaluating the comments received.
