EXPLANATORY NOTE

CS-36 Amendment 1

Executive Director Decision 2007/007/R amends Decision No. 2003/04/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 17 October 2003 on certification specifications providing for acceptable means of compliance for aircraft noise (« CS-36 »).

This Amendment 1 of CS-36 Aircraft Noise incorporates the output from the following EASA rulemaking task:
