OF 28 APRIL 2010**

amending the Annexes to Decision No. 2003/19/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 28 November 2003 on acceptable means of compliance and guidance material to Commission Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 of 20 November 2003 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of organisations and personnel involved in these tasks

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,
Having regard to the Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC¹ (hereinafter "The Basic Regulation"), and in particular Articles 18(c), 38(3)(a) and (e) thereof,

Having regard to the Commission Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 of 20 November 2003 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of organisations and personnel involved in these tasks²,

Whereas:

- (1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue certification specifications and acceptable means of compliance, as well as guidance material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its implementing rules.
- (2) Commission Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 is amended by Commission Regulation (EC) No 127/2010. This amending regulation introduces new and amended rules related to: the issue of permits to fly, the definition of principal place of business and officially recognised standard, the issue and use of the authorised release certificate EASA Form 1, the requirements for Electrical Wiring Interconnect System, and miscellaneous editorial changes.
- (3) Therefore, it is necessary to support the above amendment to Commission Regulation (EC) 2042/2003 and amend Decision No 2003/19/RM of 28 November 2003 on acceptable means of compliance and guidance material for the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the

approval of organisations and personnel involved in these tasks ('AMC and GM to (EC) No 2042/2003').

- (4) The Agency, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation and articles 5(3) and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure³, has widely consulted interested parties on the matters that are subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received⁴.

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

- (1) The Annexes I, II, III, VI, V, VI and VII to Decision 2003/19/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 28 November 2003 on acceptable means of compliance and guidance material to Commission Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 of 20 November 2003 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of organisations and personnel involved in these tasks are hereby amended as provided in the Annex to this decision.
- (2) New Annex VIII (GM to Part-M) is added.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on 5 May 2010. It shall be published in the Official Publication of the Agency.
