**DECISION N° 2005/03/R
OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY**

of 22 July 2005

**On the adoption of the amended 2005 rulemaking
programme**

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY
AGENCY,

Having regard to the decision of the Management Board concerning the procedure to be applied by the Agency for the issuing of opinions, certification specifications and guidance material ("rule making procedure") adopted on 27 June 2003, which requires, inter alia, the Executive Director to establish an annual rulemaking programme in consultation with the Safety Standards Consultative Committee and the Advisory Group of National Authorities;

In accordance with article 3.4 of the said rulemaking procedure, the Agency took into consideration the comments made by the Safety Standards Consultative Committee in its meeting on 29 June 2005 and by the Advisory Group of National Authorities in its meeting on 21 June 2005;

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

To include a new task "MDM.029" on approval of limited duration, advance task 25.009(a) from 2006 to 2005 and to adopt the attached amended 2005 Rulemaking Programme.

Article 2

Entry into force

This Decision shall enter into force on 22 July 2005. It shall be published in the *Official Publication of the Agency*, in particular through its website (www.easa.eu.int). Decision 2004/02/R of the Executive Director of the Agency, of 28 April 2005, on the adoption of the updated 2005 rulemaking programme is hereby repealed.
