ACCEPTABLE MEANS OF COMPLIANCE AND GUIDANCE MATERIAL TO COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) NO 965/2012 OF 5 OCTOBER 2012 LAYING DOWN TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES RELATED TO AIR OPERATIONS PURSUANT TO REGULATION (EC) NO 216/2008 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL

ACCEPTABLE MEANS OF COMPLIANCE AND GUIDANCE MATERIAL TO Part-ARO

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC¹, and in particular Articles 8(5) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 of 5 October 2012,

WHEREAS:

- (1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its Implementing Rules.
- (2) The Agency has, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation and Articles 5(3) and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure², widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received4.
