AMENDING DECISION No 2012/007/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY OF 19 AVRIL 2012 ON ACCEPTABLE MEANS OF COMPLIANCE AND GUIDANCE MATERIAL TO COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No 1178/2011 OF 3 NOVEMBER  $2011^1$  LAYING DOWN TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES RELATED TO CIVIL AVIATION AIRCREW PURSUANT TO REGULATION (EC) No 216/2008 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL

'Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Part-ORA'

#### THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Articles 8(5) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 of 3 November 2011

#### WHEREAS:

(1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its Implementing Rules.

Commission Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 of 3 November 2011 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to civil aviation aircrew pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council (OJ L 311, 25.11.2011).

Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC. (2) The Agency has, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation and Articles 5(3) and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure<sup>3</sup>, widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received<sup>4</sup>.

HAS DECIDED:

### Article 1

The Decision No 2012/007/R of the Executive Director of the European Aviation Safety Agency of 19 April 2012 on acceptable means of compliance and guidance material to Commission Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 of 3 November 2011 is hereby amended as provided in the Annex to this Decision.

#### Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2013. It shall be published in the Official Publication of the Agency.
