DECISION N° 01-2017

of 13 June 2017

REPEALING MANAGEMENT BOARD DECISION 01-2011
ON GUIDELINES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF CERTIFICATION TASKS TO NATIONAL
AVIATION AUTHORITIES AND QUALIFIED ENTITIES

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008¹ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC, in particular Article 33(2)(d) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Agency is in the process of negotiating Partnership Agreements with Member State national authorities;
- (2) The Partnership Agreements are intended to contain detailed guidelines for the allocation of certification tasks to national authorities with the aim to promote close cooperation in the sustainable use of available expertise;
- (3) The Agency in parallel intends to engage qualified entities with appropriate competencies through a targeted procurement procedure;
- (4) The new Partnership Agreements together with the new targeted procurement for qualified entities are intended to replace the provisions of Management Board Decision 01-2011;

(5) The Management Board may adopt a revised set of guidelines on the new approach as necessary at a later stage;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1 - Repeal

Management Board Decision 01-2011 is hereby repealed.

Article 2 – Entry into force

This Decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption. It shall be published on the Agency's website.
