# AGENCY LAUNCHES AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE NOTIFICATION WEBSITE: ad.easa.eu.int

The European Aviation Safety Agency now provides direct online access to all EU Airworthiness Directives (AD). The new website <u>ad.easa.eu.int</u> also enables visitors to search for specific ADs and to subscribe to customised email alerts according to aircraft make, model and series codes. Designed to be use-friendly, the new Airworthiness Directive notification tool includes the following features:

- links to Airworthiness Directives (ADs) and Proposed Airworthiness Directive (PADs) in pdf format
- an email alert subscription service, whereby subscribers receive an email containing ADs for aircraft according to selected makes/models/series
- a customised filter to sort ADs and PADs according to make/model/series in compliance with the ICAO uniform aircraft taxonomy
- a text search for more detailed airworthiness information

The site will be active from 11 May at 12 noon.

### **EASA Airworthiness Directives**

EASA issues Airworthiness Directives (ADs) to the holders of aircraft type-certificates whenever design-related safety problems with aircraft in Europe have been identified. The AD provides all the technical information necessary to resolve the safety problem with a specific aircraft type and gives an 'effective date' or deadline for compliance.

The prescribed corrective action is mandatory. As a result, the Airworthiness Directives section is one of the most important and most-visited pages of the Agency's website which functions as its official publication.
