1. Subject: Certification Specifications for Free Gas Balloons and Tethered Gas Balloons.

2. Problem / Statement of issue and justification; reason for regulatory evolution (regulatory tasks):

The Agency shall, in accordance with article 19 of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and Council of 20 February 2008¹ (hereafter referred to as "the Basic Regulation"), develop airworthiness codes and acceptable means of compliance for certification. This obligation is confirmed in paragraph 21A.16A of Part-21.

Because the certification of free and tethered gas balloons is within the competence of the Agency, there is a need to develop Certification Specifications for these types of aircraft.

3. Objective:

An Agency Decision introducing the initial issue of certification specifications for free gas balloons (CS-31GB) and tethered gas balloons (CS-31TGB).

4. Specific tasks and interface issues (Deliverables):

Review the draft airworthiness codes as provided by BAPE based on the (Core Group) CG9 Ad-Hoc Subgroup on Lighter-than-Air Requirements in February 2003 (See reference documents).

Develop an NPA that proposes new Certification Specifications for free gas balloons (CS-31GB) and tethered gas balloons (CS-31TGB) that are consistent with the published CS-31HB when appropriate. If required for consistency between the three balloon codes, proposals for changes to CS-31HB should be included in the NPA.
