Design certificates and design organisation approvals, Brexit

Question:

What UK CAA approved design changes will be subject to technical validation by EASA?

Answer:

The <u>Trade and Cooperation Agreement between UK and EU</u> states that type certificates, supplemental type certificates, approvals for major changes, major repairs and technical standard order authorisations issued by the UK CAA or by a UK CAA approved design organisation will not be directly accepted by EASA and will be subject to technical validation by EASA. In some cases, when agreed by UK CAA and EASA, a streamlined validation may be performed.
