EASA and EUROCONTROL are pleased to invite you to a **Competency-Based Training and Assessment (CBTA) Workshop for National Competent Authorities (NCAs)**.

This workshop is designed to support your understanding of the amendment to the **European ATCO Licensing Regulation (EU) 2015/340**, applicable from **1 January 2029**, introducing CBTA requirements for **initial training** and **operational units/training organisations**.

All initial training organisations and operational units/training organisations will be required to apply CBTA principles when designing their training courses.

- For **initial training**, the competencies have been defined and are supported by Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMCs) and Guidance Material (GMs).
- For **unit training**, operational units are required to develop their own adapted competency model and assessment processes to ensure students reach the required level of performance.

NCAs require a solid understanding of CBTA principles and their application within the regulatory context. This workshop is designed to provide that foundation.
