THE date is approaching! As of 18 February 2016, Subpart FTL will apply and AOC holders conducting commercial air transport (CAT) scheduled and charter operations with aeroplanes of a maximum operational passenger seating configuration ("MOPSC") of more than 19 must have an approved flight time specification scheme in accordance with ORO.FTL.125.

This workshop will discuss to what extent a flight time specifications scheme needs to be customised and what will be expected to demonstrate compliance with the operator responsibilities as described in ORO.FTL.110.

The event is primarily dedicated to European competent authorities, CAT operators and crew organisations.
