**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**CS-36 Amendment 2**

Executive Director Decision 2009/012/R amends Decision No 2003/04/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 17 October 2003 on certification specifications providing for acceptable means of compliance for aircraft noise ("CS-36").
