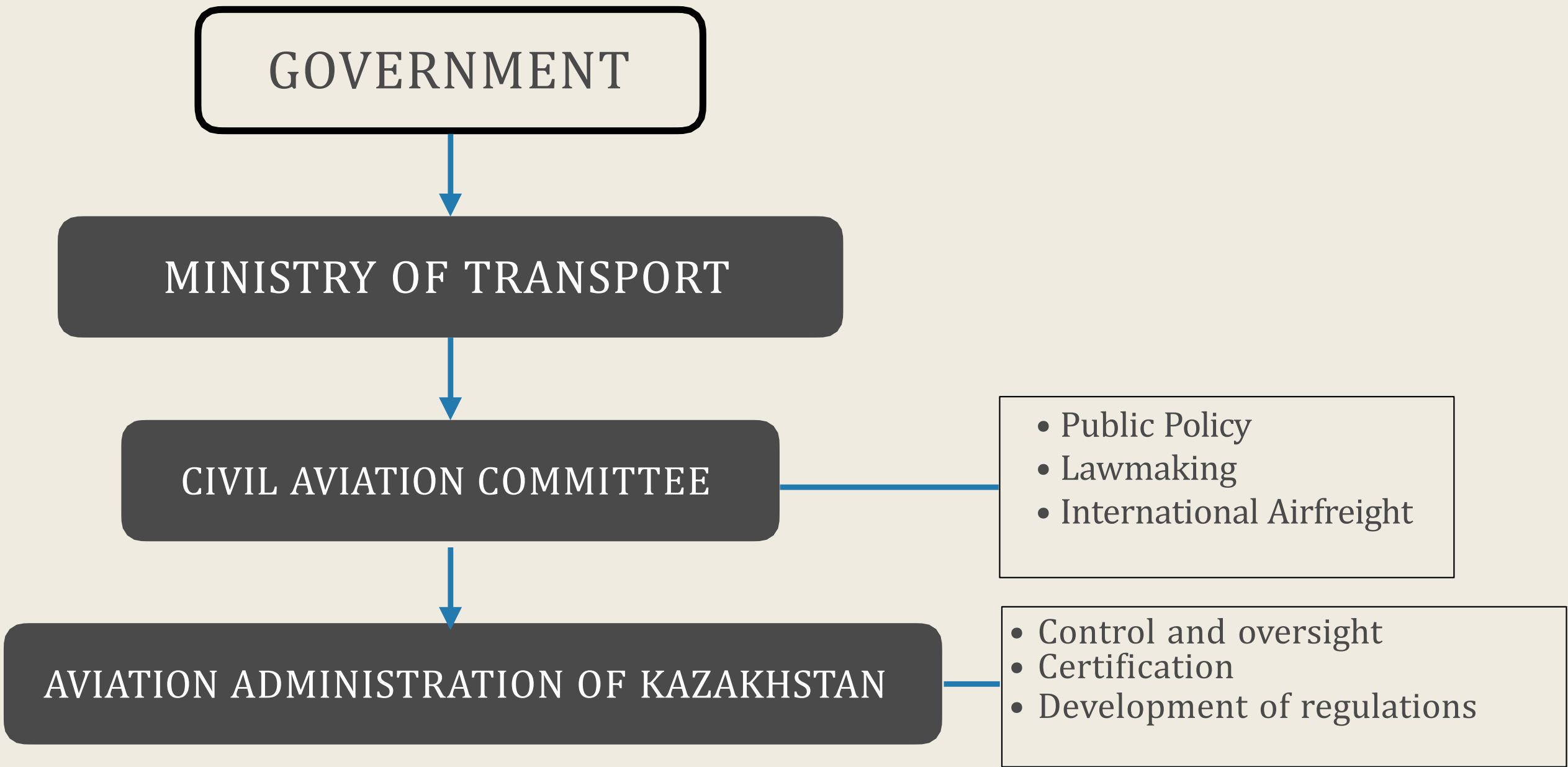

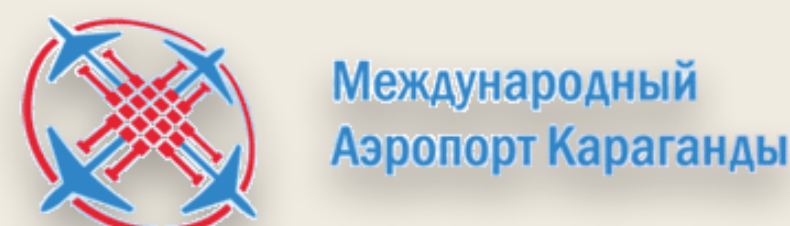
Overview of Aviation sector in Kazakhstan

- ICAO CVM level of Flight Safety - 84%
- Aircraft operators - 49, scheduled commercial - 5 airlines
- Routes: domestic - 61 routes / 694 flights per week, international - 117 routes / 581 flights per week to 31 countries
- Registered aircraft - 948, scheduled commercial - 93



Overview of Aviation sector in Kazakhstan

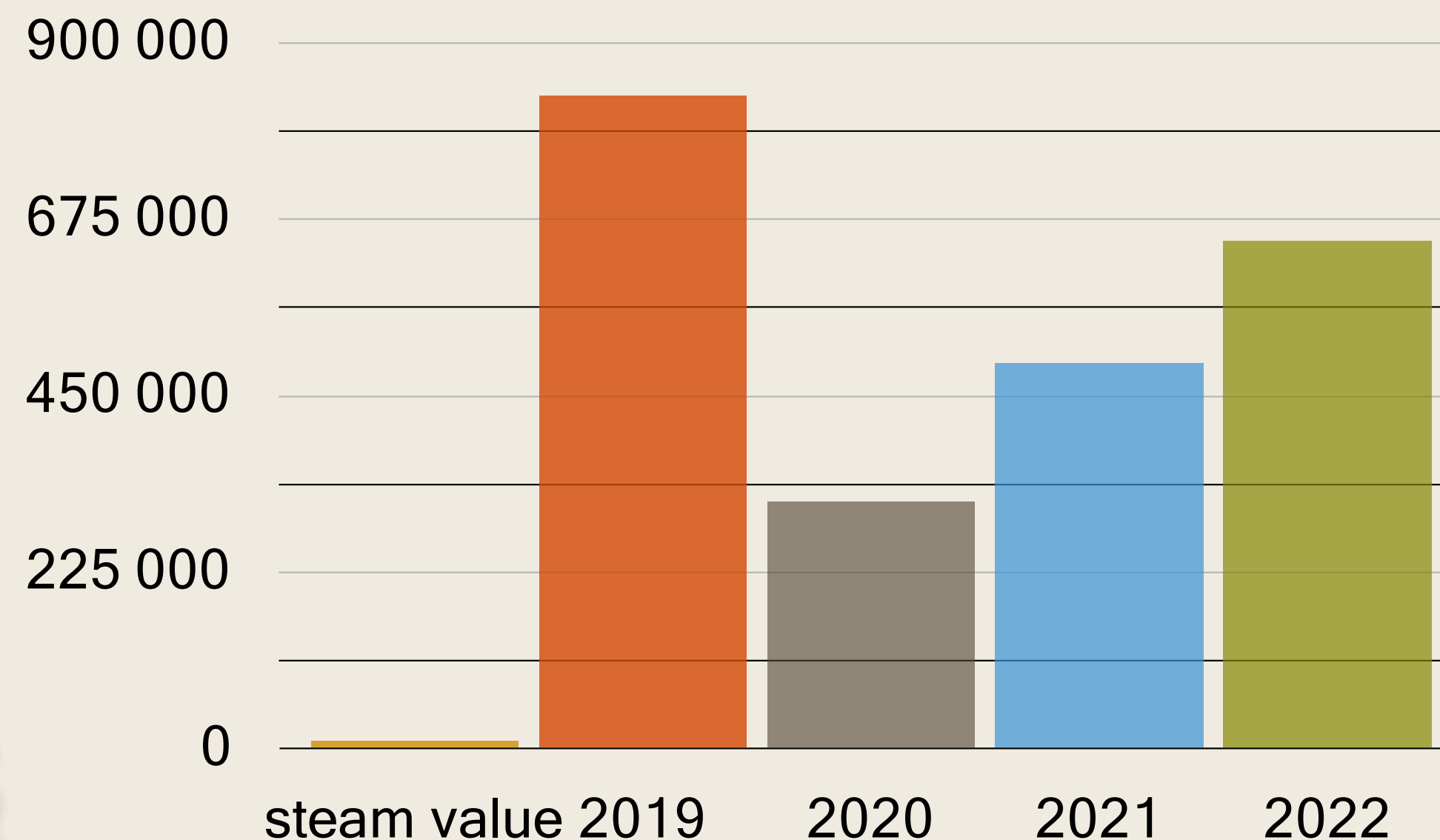
- Passenger traffic - around 13 million passengers. For 23% higher than in 2022
- Airports: domestic - 6, international - 18, «open sky regime» - 13 airports



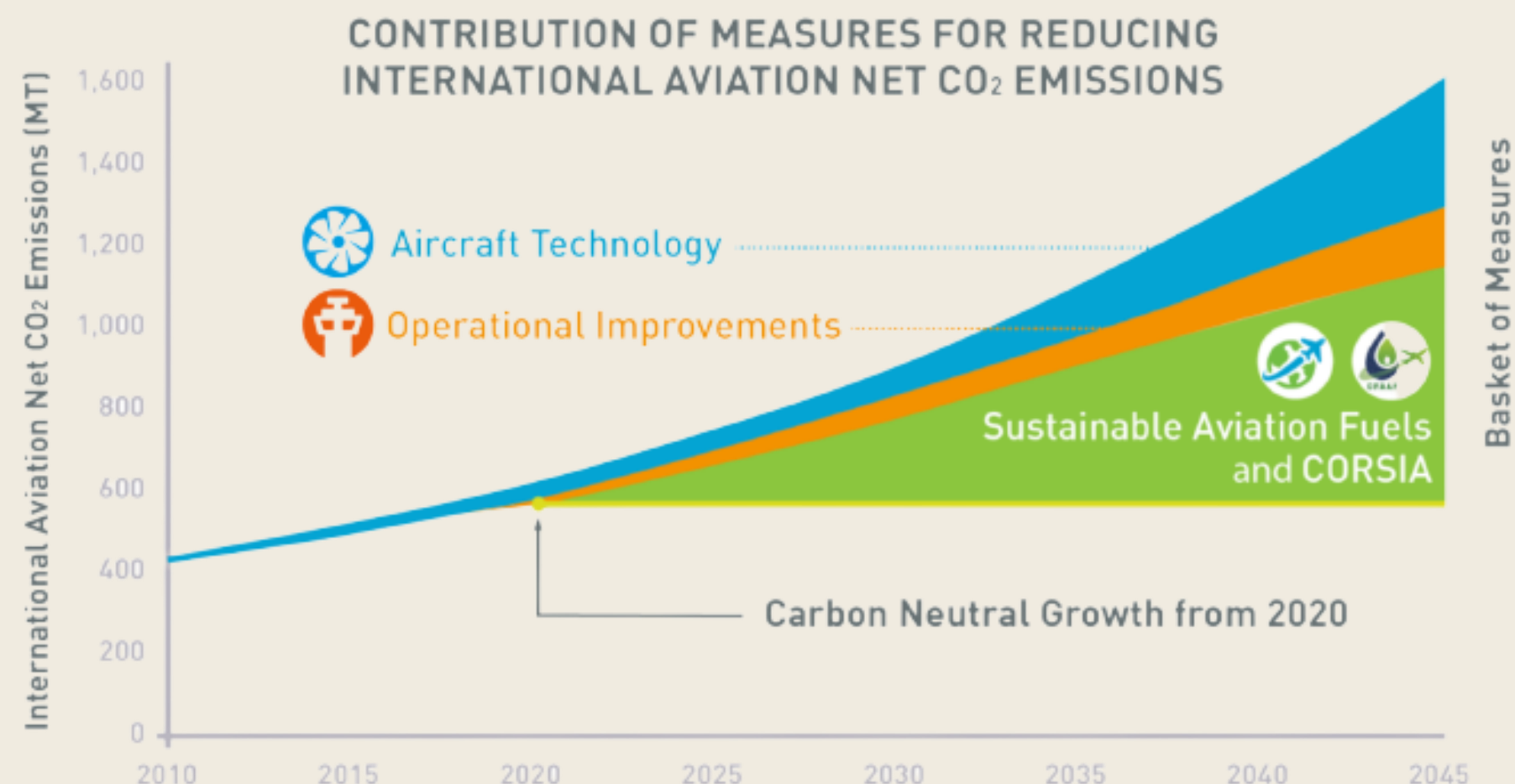
Carbon offset and reduction scheme for International Aviation - CORSIA

Number of emissions by airlines of RoK:

- for 2019 - 832 026 tons,
- for 2020 - 315 805 tons,
- for 2021 - 491 433 tons,
- for 2022 - 648 274 tons.
