### **Question:**

How does EASA treat my uncertificated ultralight/microlight aircraft?

#### Answer

If the aircraft comes within the definition of Annex II to the <u>Basic Regulation</u>, it is not an EASA type and is handled under national rules. If it does not fit into this definition it is an EASA type and is covered under the procedures below.
