Proposed amendments to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/1645
on information security risks

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/1645 laying down rules for the application of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 of the European Parliament and of the Council, as regards requirements for the management of information security risks with a potential impact on aviation safety for organisations covered by Commission Regulations (EU) No 748/2012, ~~and~~ (EU) No 139/2014, and (EU) 202x/yy [ground handling] and amending Commission Regulations (EU) No 748/2012 and (EU) No 139/2014

Article 2
Scope

1. This Regulation applies to the following organisations:

[...]

(c) Ground handling service providers subject to Regulation (EU) 202x/yy [ground handling] that:

(i) have a workforce of more than 20 full time equivalents (FTEs) involved in the activity subject to Regulation (EU) 202x/yy [ground handling]; or

(ii) in order to provide the respective services, have to collect, store, analyse or otherwise process data provided by third parties; or

(iii) provide directly to aircraft operators data that will be used for operational purposes.

Article 5
Competent authority

1. The authority responsible for certifying and overseeing compliance with this Regulation shall be:

[...]

(c) with regard to organisations referred to in Article 2, point (c), the competent authority designated in accordance with Annex II (Part-ARGH) to Regulation (EU) 202x/yy [ground handling].

[...]

Rationale

Articles 2 and 5 of Regulation (EU) 2022/1645 are proposed to be amended to extend the scope to ground handling organisations and the competent authorities of those organisations. This will ensure

the proper link with the GH Regulation, where the implementing rules for authority requirements and organisation requirements have already been introduced in the draft Opinion.

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
