Question:

What is the difference between the terms FCL (Flight Crew Licensing) and Aircrew?

Answer:

Aircrew is the common term for "Flight Crew" and "Cabin Crew". Commission Regulation (EU)

No 1178/2011 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to civil aviation aircrew ("the Aircrew Regulation") covers both flight crew and cabin crew.

Annex I (Part-FCL) to the Aircrew Regulation contains Implementing Rules for Flight Crew. Annex V (Part-CC) to the Aircrew Regulation contains Implementing Rules for Cabin Crew.
