Design certificates and design organisation approvals, Brexit

Question:

What EASA approved design changes are accepted by the UK CAA?

Answer:

The Trade and Cooperation Agreement between UK and EU states that nonsignificant supplemental type certificates, approvals of non-significant major changes, repairs and technical standard order authorisations issued by EASA or an EASA approved design organisation are accepted by the UK CAA without a need for issuance of an additional certificate. Further clarification on classification will be provided in the UK CAA/EASA TIP.
