Question:

Does EASA cover the insurance of the trainees/students?

Answer:**Graduate Traineeship Programme:**

EASA does not provide health insurance. Prior to the start date, trainees must provide proof that they are covered by a sickness insurance scheme for the entire duration of their stay at the Agency (e.g., through the European Health Insurance Card or through private insurance). If a trainee fails to provide proof of the insurance, the traineeship shall be terminated.

During the traineeship, trainees shall be covered by EASA against the risk of accident according to the relevant EASA insurance contract.

Study Placement Scheme:

EASA does not provide health insurance. Prior to the start date, students must provide proof that they are insured against accident risks either risks either privately or under the terms of their University's insurance. In addition, they should provide proof that they are covered by a sickness insurance scheme for the entire duration of their stay at the Agency (e.g., through the European Health Insurance Card or through private insurance). If a student fails to provide proof of the insurance, the traineeship shall be terminated.
