Main conclusions (1)

EASA R/SSCC/ 02-2014/
03-12-2014

- A report on the ATM/ANS RMP update was well received and no changes were proposed;
- Request launching the RM activities on Remotely Operated Tower (ROT);
- Maintenance of ATCO initial training requirements – identified as priority RMT and as a continuous process;
- FRMS RMT.0486 – postponement agreed (alignment with ICAO deliverables); however, the Agency was invited to launch the work;



Main conclusions (2)

EASA R/SSCC/ 02-2014/
03-12-2014

- CANSO and social partners are actively working on the methodology of the identification of the safety tasks in ATM/ANS (ECORYS study);
- Interest expressed by CANSO and social partners and request for active involvement on 'Just Culture' activities launched by the EC;
- Request for reconsidering the dates for the next Sub-SSCC/SSCC meetings.
