of 18 March 2020

issuing Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Annex III (Part-SFCL) to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1976

'AMC & GM to Part-SFCL — Issue 1'

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY (EASA),

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2018/11391, and in particular Article 104(3)(a) thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011, and in particular point ARA.GEN.120 of Annex VI (Part-ARA) thereto,

Whereas:

- (1) EASA shall, pursuant to Article 76(3) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, issue certification specifications and acceptable means of compliance, as well as guidance material, for the application of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and of the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof.
- (2) Acceptable means of compliance are non-binding standards issued by EASA which may be used by persons and organisations to demonstrate compliance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof.
- (3) Guidance material is non-binding material issued by EASA which helps to illustrate the meaning of a requirement or specification and is used to support the interpretation of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, the delegated and implementing acts adopted on the basis thereof, certification specifications and acceptable means of compliance.
- (4) In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2020/358², stand-alone flight crew requirements for

Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2018 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Union Aviation Safety Agency, and amending Regulations (EC) No 2111/2005, (EC) No 1008/2008, (EU) No 996/2010, (EU) No 376/2014 and Directives 2014/30/EU and 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulations (EC) No 552/2004 and (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EEC) No 3922/91 (OJ L 212, 22.8.2018, p. 1) (https://eurlex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/?qid=1535612134845&uri=CELEX:32018R1139).

- sailplanes were laid down as Annex III (Part-SFCL) to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/19763. Therefore, EASA has to issue Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) for the new Part-SFCL.
- EASA shall, pursuant to Article 4(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the field of aviation. For the development of the AMC and GM to Part-SFCL, certain sailplane-specific AMC and GM to Annex I (Part-FCL) to Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011⁴ have been used and revised where necessary in light of the more proportionate requirements for sailplane flight crew licensing laid down in Part-SFCL.
- EASA, pursuant to Article 115(1)(c) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 and Article 16 'Special (6) rulemaking procedure: accelerated procedure' of the EASA Rulemaking Procedure⁵ has consulted the affected stakeholders as well as its Advisory Bodies on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has considered the comments received,

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

The Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Annex III (Part-SFCL) to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1976 are those laid down in the Annex to this Decision.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Publication of EASA.

It shall apply from 8 April 2020.
