Recipients of personal data:

Personal data may be accessed only by the EASA Staff dealing with the organisation of the distribution of EASA Press Releases, EASA Newsletter and any relevant EASA communications.

Data are also transferred to Campaign Monitor Pty Ltd (ABN 42 094 533 445) ("Campaign Monitor") which, in respect of Regulation (EC) 2018/1725, shall through the Campaign Monitor software product, enable EASA to collect visitor email addresses and to create, launch, and manage online email campaigns and newsletters.

This is without prejudice to a possible transfer to bodies in charge of a monitoring, auditing or inspection function in accordance with European Union legislation.

Data retention:

Collected personal data are recorded and stored as long as they will no longer be needed for the purpose of the managing of the efficient distribution of EASA press releases, EASA Newsletter and any relevant EASA communications to involved parties.
