Privacy statement

Processing of personal data on Medical certificates and pilot licences of the EASA pilots. (EASA ED Decision 2012/125/E)

Personal data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

Purpose:

Pursuing the aim of EASA ED Decision 2012/125/E, the purpose of this personal data processing is to manage, store, process personal data of the EASA staff who, to perform their selected duties, are required to hold an flight-crew licence. The Agency and the staff member shall take all necessary measures to manage, store and process personal data of EASA Pilots preventing any situation that could compromise the Agency activity.

Personal data collected and further processed:

All personnel who, to pursue a specific position must have a specific flight-crew licence, shall release to the Agency all relevant documents and data, linked to the privileges of the licence required.

These data will be processed:

- EASA Pilots' aircrew licences.
- EASA Pilots' aero-medical certificates.
- EASA Pilots' official pilot logbooks.
- EASA Pilots' flight simulator reports.
- Other documents linked to their flight-crew licences.

Recipients of personal data:

The EASA designated data collector within the Aircrew and Medical Department at EASA, without prejudice to a possible transfer to bodies in charge of a monitoring, auditing or inspection function in accordance with European Union legislation.

Data retention:

Collected personal data are recorded and stored as long as the person in question is an employee of EASA or remains in a contractual agreement with EASA.
