Processing of personal data on the occasion of assessing a proposed deviating Individual Flight Time Specification Scheme (IFTSS)

Personal data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

Purpose:

For the purpose of assessing proposed deviating Individual Flight Time Specification Schemes (IFTSS), as foreseen by Art. 76(7) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139, the Agency is using a pool of external experts that has been established with ED Decision 2014/193/E.

Personal data collected and further processed:
