



Privacy statement

Processing of personal data on the occasion of managing of flexibility measures (Art. 71 EU Reg. 2018/1139)

Personal data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

Purpose:

The purpose of the personal data processing is to guarantee the managing of personal data collected during the activity of evaluation of flexibility measures requested by an EASA Member State in accordance with Art. 71 of EU Reg. 2018/1139. Under these circumstances Member State have to send all relevant information with practical and real references to allow to EASA to make a recommendation. This information might contain personal data of people involved, directly or indirectly, with the exemption.

Personal data collected and further processed:

All relevant personal data sent by the Member States, as part of the notification of a flexibility measure or as a result of an additional information request for EASA side.

The type of data collected is:

- Contact data of the competent authority which has notified the use of a flexible measure including the full name and contact details of the focal point designated by the respective competent authority for the contact with EASA.
- The data stored may include the full name, and licence number, ratings or certificates data of the individuals for which the exemption is granted.

Recipients of personal data:

EASA experts involved with the assessment of the relevant flexibility measures, collect and process the data, without prejudice to a possible transfer to bodies in charge of a monitoring, auditing or inspection function in accordance with European Union legislation.

Data retention:

The data is stored, processed and managed as long as it is useful for the handling of the procedures following the current European Legislation. Data is stored in EASA facilities for as long as it will constitute a valid reference for further decisions.
