Processing of personal data on the occasion of the Experts FSTD Operator Evaluation (EFOE)

Personal data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC.

Purpose:

The purpose of the processing is to gather information about the performance of FSTD operators during the audit of their management system or FSTD evaluations performed by EASA, to adjust their oversight program. This is done via the "EUSurvey" tool managed by Directorate-General for Informatics (DIGIT) of the European Commission. The objective is to move toward performance and risk base oversight of FSTD organisation. (Annex VI Part ARA of Regulation 1178/2011: ARA.GEN.305). The personal data (Name and email address) is needed to identify the personal who makes the reporting.

Personal data collected and further processed:

The following personal data of the Technical or Flight Inspector who performed the activity (OMS audit or FSTD evaluation) will be collected:

- Name (first, last);
- Email address;
