1. What personal data do we collect?

2. For what purpose do we collect personal data and on which legal basis?

The personal data are collected in order to grant access to the European Information Sharing and Cooperation Platform on Conflict Zones.

The legal basis for collecting the data is Article 5 (d) of the Regulation (EU) 2018 / 1725. In absence of the data subject's unequivocal consent to the processing of the personal data as requested in the Registration Form will result in the rejection of the application to join the European Information Sharing and Cooperation Platform on Conflict Zones.

3. Who may receive your personal data?

Your personal data is processed only by persons (EASA staff or EASA contractors) involved in managing the authorizations to access the Platform at EASA.



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4. How long are your personal data kept?

Your personal data will be kept for the time during which your membership to the Platform is active. Once the membership is over, all personal data will be deleted.

5. What are your rights?

You have the right to request from EASA access to and rectification or erasure of your personal data or restriction of processing.

You also have the right to withdraw at any time your consent for EASA to process your personal data. This will result in termination of your membership in the Platform. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before the withdrawal.

EASA should provide information on actions taken upon a request within one month of receipt of the request. That period may be extended by two further months where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of the requests.

A breach concerning personal data bearing a risk to the rights and freedoms of the data subject will be communicated to you. EASA will also ensure the confidentiality of electronic communications.

6. Who is the data controller and how to exercise your rights?

EASA exercises the tasks of the data controller for the purpose of these processing operations.
