As part of the technical activities related to the "WP4 - Competency Development" of the Eastern Partnership and Central Asia (EaP/CA) project, a five-day on-site support in the area of air navigation services was provided to the Civil Aviation Authority of Armenia in Yerevan from 12 to 16 November 2018.

The main objective was to provide on-site support for the development of an ATM/ANS inspector procedures manual. The activity was designed to support the CAA in preparing or updating their own material and to provide advice on the development of a training plan. The key topics encompassed administrative procedures, checklist development, inspection guides and quality control as well as qualification requirements.
